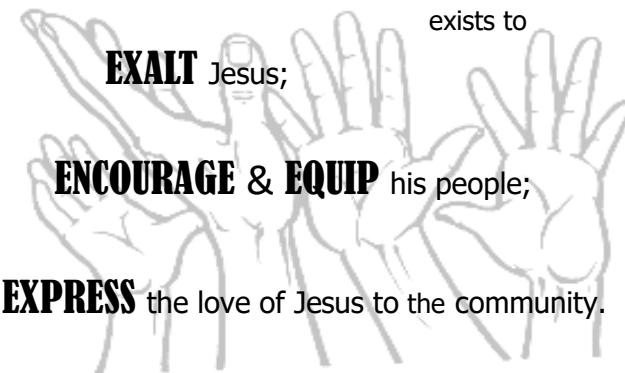

Pray for Betsy Frye as she is in the hospital at St. Pierre. She is doing better and hopes to come home soon.

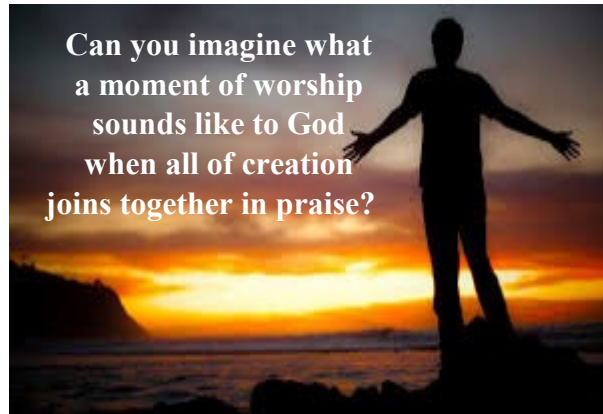
