Diego Davile, a Quechua man from Santa Cruz, Boiva sent us an email. Quechua is one of the largest language groups in South America. In 2007 Ernesto, our Spanish Ministry Director, trained Diego to record his own "Encuentro" style programs in the Quechua language.

Now, 10 years later, Diego writes: "On October 12th, I completed the 500th radio program of "Encuentro". These programs air on more than 70 stations. We praise God for the opportunity to serve in this ministry. A greeting for Pastor Ernesto; what good memories we have from his visit to Boliva when we began producing the radio program Quechua."

So we thank you again for your support. Whatever we may plan or set out to do, we can know that God's ideas are greater, His love for people reaches further, and His success rate is exactly what He wants it to be.
