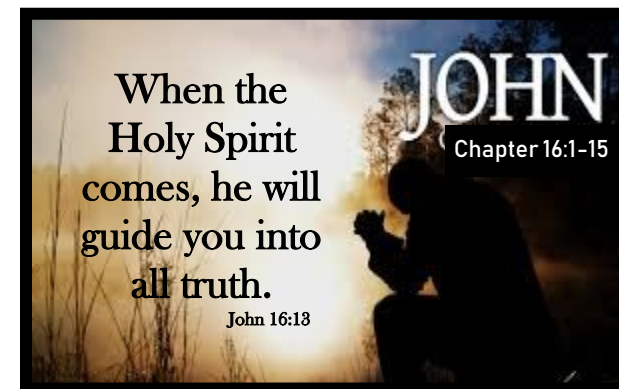

Planted By Streams of Water

John has been on the street for most of his life. He's led a hard life and you can tell by his bushy, greying beard and the wrinkled, weathered look to his face. But John always has a smile and pleasant, mild-mannered demeanor about him. Despite all the hardships, he has a joy that seems always to be present. One day I complimented him on his positive attitude. He responded that it comes from being able to spend one more day with Jesus. He said he learned to live that way by spending time with Christ, and said the chapel services and the meals were an important part of his time with Jesus. It was like coming to a cold stream of water on a hot day, he said—like that stream of water in Psalm chapter one. I knew immediately what he was talking about and I was humbled at how well John knew Jesus in his heart.

Psalm 1:3 says this about someone who walks with God daily and has Him as his strength: "He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither." John found the streams of water he needed in Christ at Union Gospel Mission through the chapel services and the meals. This, and being able to chat with people who love Jesus as he does, has given John the strength and joy he needs to get through each day. John's pleasant demeanor is the fruit that is yielded through those streams of living water found only in Christ. May we all drink from that stream of life in Jesus today.
